



Coach / Player Coach

Reports to: Director of Cricket

Brief: The player coach/coach role will set up or delegate training sessions & activities for their team based on the club's 'brand' of cricket. This role is not the captain & will assist in the development of the younger developing players within their team.

Responsibilities:

1. Organise systems for the Club Coaching Team to discuss relevant coaching matters as appropriate.
2. Support and ensure the younger players in the team are given appropriate team roles.
3. Plan and lead fun and safe coaching sessions, working alongside other coaches and coaching teams.
4. Observe and analyse skills, suggesting improvements and making players aware of their progress.
5. Put into action the coaching elements of the Club Development Plan.
6. Mentor new coaches and Young Leaders.
7. Reflect and evaluate coaching sessions.
8. Delegate organisational roles which don't require coaching skills.
9. Liaise with NWCU to access regional and national structures for talented performers.
10. Promote and abide by club policy, child protection, fair play, Code of Conduct and equal opportunities.
11. Follow procedure for reporting accidents.

Guide: Be an active member of the club continually striving to provide coaching to each playing member of the club to ensure they are best supported for their & the clubs development.

Commitment: 2-4 Hours per week
