



## Cricket Professional / Development Officer

**Reports to:** Club Cricket Committee

**Brief:** To deliver and action participation &/or performance elements of the club's Development Plan.

### Responsibilities

1. Act as lead administrator and/or organiser for (club) youth coaching programmes at specified groups.
2. Play an appropriate coaching role in the above programmes (as agreed)
3. Organise & lead cricket coaching Summer 'Camps' at the club
4. Assist with cricket summer 'Camps' with partner clubs, liaising with partner club coaches & professional Cricketers.
5. Act as lead coach of the clubs Women's team & take part in Men's senior training, set the standard for club training.
6. Deliver cricket sessions to 'feeder' schools & actively encourage the kids to come and play cricket in the club.
7. Attend meetings and prepare verbal or written reports / feedback for the club's cricket committee.

**Guide:** Be a role model for young cricketers to aspire to & assist in ensuring the club has lasting benefits from your involvement as a Development Officer/Professional Cricketer

**Commitment:** 10-20 hours per week (or as agreed)
