NWCU Positive Test & Isolation 2021



This guidance applies is correct from May 2021 & for further guidance please follow the current government guidelines.

Positive Test	Close Contact	Club
<p>If there is a player who has tested positive, they must from that point self-isolate (or if they have symptoms, from the moment of symptoms).</p> <p>The player should contact NHS 111 and NHS Test and Trace will pick up from this point.</p>	<p>People you spend 15 minutes or more with, at less than two metres.</p> <p>People you have direct contact with – such as household members & partners.</p> <p>People with whom you have had face-to-face conversations at less than one metre.</p>	<p>The Club can carry on, but be mindful to ensure all the guidelines are strictly followed on social distancing, hand washing etc. If Test and Trace contact them, they must provide the details and then if deemed anyone needs to isolate on their instruction, do so.</p>
	<p>Match play is not considered 'close contact' so no action is needed unless individuals experience symptoms, in which case they must self-isolate from that point as per Government guidance.</p>	
	<p>If anyone had been identified as a close contact or Test and Trace contact them, they must provide the details and then if deemed anyone needs to isolate on their instruction, do so.</p>
