Method of Scoring on Sheet

- . = no run, no wicket
- W = wicket taken
- 1,2,3 = runs scored
- O = no ball - number of runs written inside
- (2) = wide ball - number of runs written inside bracket

Don't forget

- Batting starts with 200 runs
- Runs added to total
- 5 Runs deducted if batsman is out
- Give extra ball for wide or no ball in last over
- A batsman can not be out caught, stumped or hit wicket off a no ball

Example of a 2 over spell (5 runs deducted for each wicket lost)

1st Over
 no run , four, wicket falls
 wide no extra runs scored from it
 no run , one run
 7 runs , 1 wicket $200+7-5 = 202$

2nd Over
 wicket, one run
 three runs run off a no ball [3 scored, 2 for no ball ignored]
 no ball - two runs taken [2 scored for no ball only]
 three runs, no run
 9 runs, 1 wicket = $202+9 - 5 = 206$
